STEP ONE

Download, install, and activate free software before downloading digital materials.

For OverDrive Audiobook Titles

Install OverDrive Media Console™

Go to: overdrive.com/software/omc

Choose the version needed for your computer or mobile device. Check system requirements and follow instructions to download and install.

***For Windows:** The first time that Windows Media Player attempts to open a file, it will alert you that a security upgrade must be performed before the file can be opened. The upgrade takes just a few moments.*

Take OverDrive Audiobook Titles with you on-the-go.

Many audio titles can be burned to CD, and most audio titles can be transferred to supported portable devices.

For Adobe eBooks

1. Downloading to your computer (Mac or PC):

Install Adobe[®] Digital Editions

Go to: adobe.com/products/digitaleditions

Select **Download now** and follow instructions to download, install, and activate. Transfer to a supported eBook device. For a list of devices go to: overdrive.com/resources/drc

2. Downloading to your mobile device

Android, Blackberry, iPhone/iPad, Windows Mobile, and Windows Phone 7: Get the free OverDrive Media Console App at overdrive.com/software/omc

For Mobipocket eBooks install Mobipocket Reader

Go to: mobipocket.com/en/DownloadSoft/ProductDetailsReader.asp

Select **Download** and follow instructions to download and install. Mobipocket Reader requires registration. For use with Windows operating systems only. Transfer to Windows Mobile[®]-based Smartphones and some PDAs.

To register Mobipocket Reader, sign in at the above site using your library card number. Update your account information with your Mobipocket Reader PID(s) (a unique registration code called a Personal Identifier). You can register up to three PIDs, enabling you to read Mobipocket eBooks on up to three devices.

For Mobipocket eBooks install Mobipocket Reader

Check Out:

Add your titles to the **shopping cart** and check out.

Download:

A download page is displayed. Click the **Download** link and follow the on-screen steps.

Enjoy:

Once the download is complete, open and enjoy the title from your computer or mobile device. You may also transfer from your computer to a supported portable device.

- You will never accrue late fees with titles you download from this site. At the end of the loan period, titles expire and are automatically 'returned' to the library. At this time, you can delete the expired file(s) from your computer.
- If you find a title that you are interested in checking out at a future date, you can add it to your **Wish List**.
