

MyMediaMall® is a free online service provided to Glenview Library patrons for selecting hundreds of Audiobooks and eBooks to listen to or read on your computer, PDA, or other compatible devices. Access **MyMediaMall®** at glenviewpl.org or www.mymediama.net. For a list of supported devices, go to overdrive.com/resources/drc.

STEP ONE: On your first visit, download, install and activate free software that best suits your needs BEFORE downloading digital materials.

For OverDrive Audiobook Titles

1. **Install OverDrive Media Console™ to download audiobooks to your computer (Mac or PC).** Go to overdrive.com/software/omc. Choose the version needed for your computer. Check system requirements and follow instructions to download and install. **For Windows:** *The first time that Windows Media Player attempts to open a file, it will alert you that a security upgrade must be performed before the file can be opened (this takes just a few moments).*
2. **Take OverDrive Audiobook Titles with you on-the-go.** Using the OverDrive Media Console software, many audio titles can be burned to CD, and most audio titles can be transferred to supported portable devices. For a list of supported devices go to overdrive.com/resources/drc.
3. **Download audiobooks directly to your mobile device:** Android, Blackberry, iPhone/iPad, and Windows Phone 7. Get the free OverDrive Media Console App at overdrive.com/software/omc.

For Adobe eBooks

1. **Install Adobe Digital Editions to download eBooks to your computer (Mac or PC).** Go to adobe.com/products/digitaleditions. Select "Download Now" and follow instructions to download, install, and activate. For a list of devices go to overdrive.com/resources/drc.
2. **Download eBooks directly to your mobile device:** Android, Blackberry, iPhone/iPad, and Windows Phone 7. Get the free Overdrive Media Console App at overdrive.com/software/omc. **Please note:** *Overdrive Media Console apps are compatible with ePub formatted books only.*

For Kindle Books *Please note: Software download is not necessary for Kindle.*

STEP TWO: Sign in, Search, Check Out, Download, and Enjoy.

Sign In: A Glenview Public Library Card is required to sign in to your account.

Search: Browse or search www.mymediama.net using the Quick or Advanced search options in the upper left corner or by exploring one of the collections listed on the homepage. **Search tip:** Narrow your search to find only titles that are available for immediate download by checking the box "Only Available Copies" while using the Quick Search or the Advanced Search.

Check Out: Add your titles to the shopping cart and check out.

Download: A download page is displayed. Click the "Download" link and follow the on-screen steps. **Please note:** *for Kindle titles, you will need to click the "Get for Kindle" link.*

Enjoy: Once the download is complete, open and enjoy the title from your computer or mobile device. You may also transfer from your computer to a supported portable device.

- You will never accrue late fees with titles you download from this site. At the end of the loan period, titles expire and are automatically returned to the library. At this time, you can delete the expired file(s) from your computer or other device.
- If you find a title that you are interested in checking out at a future date, you can add it to your Wish List.
- If a desired title is not available, you can place it on hold. You will be notified by email when the title is available.
