There were **other Chicago newspapers** in which people might have put obituaries and death notices, but which the Glenview Public Library does not own. Some examples of other newspapers in which to search are the Chicago Sun Times, The Chicago American, and the Chicago Daily News, as well as many ethnic and religious newspapers. The Illinois Newspaper Project online database holds information about newspapers in Illinois. Use it to locate newspaper titles and where they are held.
