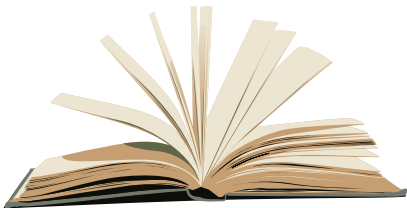

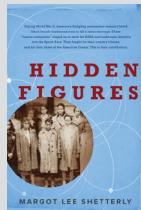

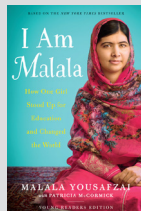


*Who Helped Win the Space Race*
