



Quiet Study Room Use Policy

The Glenview Public Library provides a Quiet Study Room, as distinguished from study rooms and meeting rooms, for those people wanting an environment conducive to quiet study or reading. This room is available during normal Library hours.

There is no time limit or reservation required to use this room. The room may be occupied by as many as sixteen patrons simultaneously, on a first come, first served basis.

In order to maintain a quiet environment, the following restrictions apply:

- Conversations are not allowed except in cases where staff needs to communicate with persons using the Quiet Study Room.
- Cell phones must be turned off or set to vibrate.

The use of electronic equipment in this room is allowed, but there shall be no audio, not even through earphones. This includes, but is not limited to, laptops, iPads, iPhones, Blackberry-type devices, radios, MP3 players, iPods, sound equipment with earphones, and the like.

The Library reserves the right to deny use of the Quiet Study Room to anyone that fails to adhere to the above rules and restrictions.
